GETTING TO GREAT DIAMOND ISLAND

Valet parking for guests of the inn is available at the lot at 75 Commercial St. right across from the terminal where you'll take a 30-minute sail across Casco Bay via ferry or water-taxi. The island is not accessible by car and primary modes of transportation are walking and bicycles. The \$40 parking charge will be billed through the inn.

THE INN AT DIAMOND COVE is the centerpiece of Diamond Cove, a small private community of beautiful residences that was once Fort McKinley, a military base built between 1891 and 1907 to defend Portland Harbor during the Spanish-American War. Formerly army barracks, the Inn has been restored with meticulous attention to historic detail.

GREAT DIAMOND ISLAND

Great Diamond Island in Casco Bay is one of the most picturesque islands in Maine offering 193 acres of spectacular natural landscape perfect for outdoor recreation and relaxing. Prior to being an army base, Diamond Cove was a famous artists' retreat where American literary greats such as Henry Wadsworth Longfellow and Harriet Beecher Stowe spent time.
